Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) generally does not cover "routine" screening tests. Medical necessity must be demonstrated for coverage. Please obtain and submit an Advance Beneficiary Notice (ABN) signed by the Medicare beneficiary for any NCD/LCD test that is not supported by a diagnosis that meets CMS's limited coverage/medical necessity requirements.

Presumptive drug screens are performed using an immunoassay analyzer. The drug screen is a qualitative test and will yield either a NEGATIVE or POSITIVE result by drug class only and is generally not drug specific. Immunoassay tests generally have a higher cut-off concentration than tests performed with LC/MS/MS. Presumptive test procedure code G0479 is billed as a single unit, no matter the number of drug classes inclusive of the drug screen ordered. Presumptive screens may be ordered individually by adding them in the "Additional Tests" section on the front of the form. Only tests under the Urine and Oral Fluid Qualitative Test columns above may be ordered individually.

Reflex Testing - Since we do not have access to patient-specific data, CMS has deemed reflex testing under the following circumstances as reasonable and necessary:

- To verify a presumptive positive test using definitive methods before reporting presumptive findings to the ordering clinician
- To confirm the absence of prescribed medications when a negative result is obtained by presumptive test in the laboratory for a prescribed medication listed or included in the test order by the ordering clinician.

Definitive Tests are performed using LC/MS/MS to positively identify the individual drugs in the sample and the results are reported in concentration of drug in the sample (e.g. ng/mL). Definitive testing should only be ordered when deemed medically necessary by healthcare provider. For example, if healthcare provider desires to test at levels below the cutoff for qualitative immunoassay screens or if cross-reactivity and/or drug specificity are concerns.

Each drug in the above table is considered a single drug class except for the following:

- Amphetamine drug class consists of the analyte group - Amphetamine & Methamphetamine
- Muscle Relaxant drug class consists of the analyte group - Carisoprodol & Cyclobenzaprine
- Opiate drug class consists of the analyte group - Codeine/Morphine, Hydrocodone/Norhydrocodone & Hydromorphone
- Alkaloid drug class consists of the analyte group - Cotinine & Kratom
- Opioid/Opiate Analog drug class consists of the analyte group - Meperidine, Naloxone & Naltrexone
- Oxycodone - Oxycodone & Oxymorphone

Only one Definitive test procedural code (G0480, G0481, G0482, & G0483) is billed per patient, per date of service and is dependent on the total number of drug class tests ordered.

Patient specific profiles should be determined by the clinician based upon the following medical necessity guidance criteria:

- Patient history, physical examination, and previous laboratory findings
- Current stage of treatment plan
- Suspected abuse substance(s), prescribed medication(s) and potential drug-to-drug interactions
- Risk Assessment plan.

Frequency of testing should be based upon a patients number of consecutive days abstinence or risk level. Any additional tests beyond recommendations must be justified by the clinician in the medical records in situations in which changes in prescribed medications may be needed. Please reference Noridian LCD L36668 for additional details on coverage limitations.

The samples shall be destroyed no more than ten (10) weeks after receipt at the lab. Results will be provided to your healthcare provider(s).
